Goforth, Ken MCM 1976
Thirtieth Anniversary Celebration
On August 7, 2005, the Scottsville, Kentucky, Baptist Church
hosted an extensive celebration honoring Minister of Music Ken
Goforth for 30 years of service. In 1975, his last semester as a
Southern Seminary student, Ken commuted from Louisville to
Scottsville, with the understanding that he would move his
family there and continue serving upon graduation.
On Saturday night of the celebratory weekend a
banquet was held at the local school, and speakers from the
church and the community were chosen to characterize the
various phases of Ken's ministry. Going far beyond his job
description, the testimonies reflected three decades of influence
