Hershael W. York

Hershael W. York serves as Associate Professor of Christian Preaching at The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, a position he has held since 1997.

Dr. York served as Associate Pastor of Ashland Avenue Baptist Church, Lexington, KY, from 1980 to 1987, Senior Pastor of First Baptist Church, Marion, AR, from 1988 to 1990, and as Senior Pastor of Ashland Avenue Baptist Church, Lexington, KY, from 1990 to 1997. During his tenure in Lexington, York led the church to excel in evangelism. Ashland Avenue became the first church ever to become a national clinic base within two years of implementing Evangelism Explosion.

Dr. York received the Bachelor of Arts and Master of Arts from the University of Kentucky, the Master of Divinity and Doctor of Philosophy from Mid-America Baptist Theological Seminary.
