Treasurer's Report.

LOUISVILLE, KY., October 11th, 1876.

To the Baptist Centennial Committee, Louisville, Ky.

DEAR BRETHREN :

I herewith hand you my report, showing amount of Centennial funds received and disbursed by me. I have received of J. N. Bradley, collector of Great Crossing Church, Elk Horn Association, draft for \$51 58; and he also sends receipt of Geo. V. Payne, Treasurer of Georgetown College for \$20; also C. W. Threlkeld's letter, addressed to G. W. Norton, with draft for \$11—letter bearing date 25th September, Harrisburg, Owen County, Kentucky. Said letter and draft has been delivered to me by G. W.
